

Super Speedy Car Coasters

Crochet Pattern

Supplies

- Worsted Weight Cotton Yarn - I used WeCrochet Dishie and Hobby Lobby's I Love This Cotton
- J10/6 mm Crochet Hook
- Scissors
- Yarn Needle

Finished Size

Approximately 2.5 inches in diameter

Special Stitches

Magic Circle: [Here is a great video tutorial to help you create a magic circle!](#)

Abbreviations (US Terms)

CH: Chain
SL ST: Slip Stitch
DC: Double Crochet
FO: Finish Off

Gauge (Not Essential)

Using a J10/6 mm crochet hook and 3 strands of worsted weight cotton yarn, a magic ring with 6 DC should measure about 1.5 inches in diameter. After completing round 2 with 2 DC in each stitch, it should measure approximately 2.5 inches in diameter.

Tips & Tricks

Working with Three Strands of Yarn

To work with three strands of yarn for this pattern, you could pull from three separate skeins, or you could use [this super cool trick to get three strands to crochet with while only pulling from one strand of yarn!](#)

More Tips & Tricks

Creating a Straight Seam in the Round

Alexandra of the [EyeLoveKnots blog](#) introduced me to this awesome tip for keeping your seam straight while crocheting in the round with joined rounds! For the second round, after you chain 2, you will only put one DC in the first stitch. You then continue to DC 2 in each stitch around. This will give you 11 DC when you get back to your original chain. Then, you can DC 1 right where the CH 2 was and join your work.

I think this looks the best, so you will see this in the written pattern below as the recommended method for row 2. If you are not comfortable with this method, you could also just DC 2 in each stitch around.

Creating an Invisible Finish

I use an alternative method for finishing off at the end of the coaster. You can check out this method at the end of the video tutorial found below.

Super Speedy Crocheted Car Coasters Crochet Pattern

Using three strands of worsted weight yarn held together:

Create a Magic Circle and CH 2.

Row 1: DC 6 into a Magic Circle. Join with a SL ST into the first DC, CH 2. (6)

Row 2 (recommended): DC 1 in the first. Then DC 2 in each of the next five stitches. DC 1 in the last stitch stitch (where the CH 2 was). Join with a SL ST into the first DC. (12)

Row 2 (alternative): DC 2 in each stitch around. Join with a SL ST into the first DC. (12)

Fasten off and weave in ends. You're all done!
